Technique Scaffold Revision

Whenever you are analysing any technique, use the following IEEL scaffold to ensure that you provide all of the information required to generate a detailed response.

Vocab Tips!

Other words for *techniques* include: *tools, devices, ways, features, aspects, conventions, elements, representation*. If a question uses the word "**how**" it is asking for you to discuss techniques.

Other words for *shows* include: *conveys, portrays, illuminates, delineates, illustrates, communicates, highlights, outlines, depicts, demonstrates, explores, displays, presents*.

IEEL SCAFFOLD

- **IDENTIFY** the technique (for this topic it will mostly be a device that shapes perspective)
- Provide at least one **EXAMPLE** (textual reference)
- Explain the **EFFECT** (how effective is the technique in conveying the perception?)
- **LINK** the analysis to the question or the concept (or another text if the question asks you to compare).
